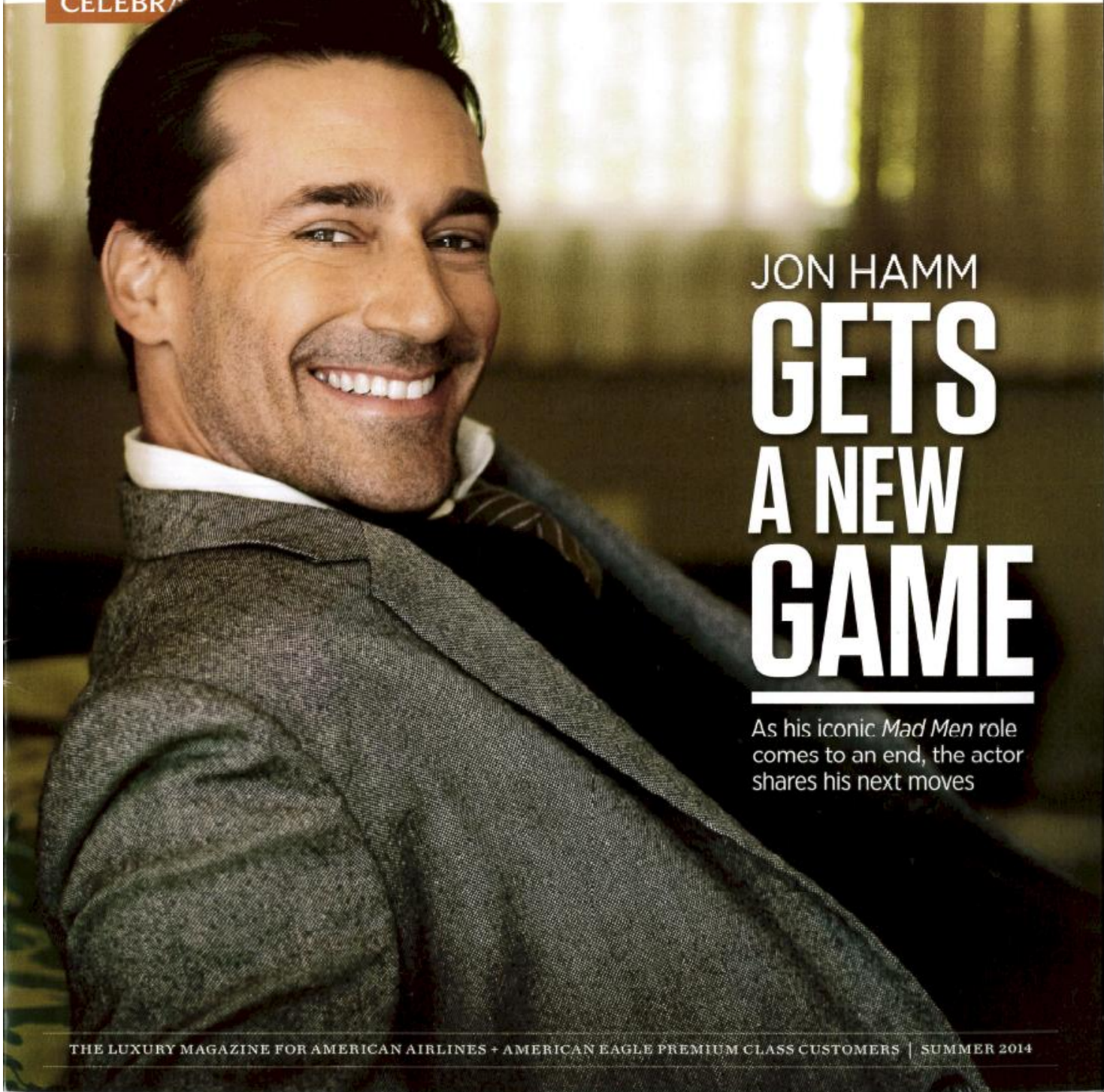

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From mountaintop to seaside, there's a new resort for every vacation style.

VINEYARD: Just 22 villas amid 1,500 acres of Mendoza, Argentina, vineyards and a restaurant by popular chef Francis Mallmann make a strong food-and-wine case for visiting [The Vines Resort & Spa](#).

MOUNTAIN: In Switzerland, 102-room-and-suite [The Chedi Andermatt](#), part of a planned golf and ski resort, modernizes the mountain chalet with a 10-room spa, indoor and outdoor pools, and several restaurants.

DESERT: On a 650-foot bluff overlooking Palm Springs, 244-room [The Ritz-Carlton, Rancho Mirage](#) keeps its cool with multiple swimming pools and a 24,000-square-foot spa.

THEME PARK: Opening August 3 with 444 rooms, [Four Seasons Resort Orlando at Walt Disney World Resort](#) bridges the generations with a Tom Fazio golf course, multiple pools, and fireworks views from a rooftop restaurant.

BEACH: In Honduras, the just-opened [Indura Beach & Golf Resort](#) hosts 60 accommodations and a Gary Player golf course on 1,800 acres next to a wildlife-rich national park.

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
